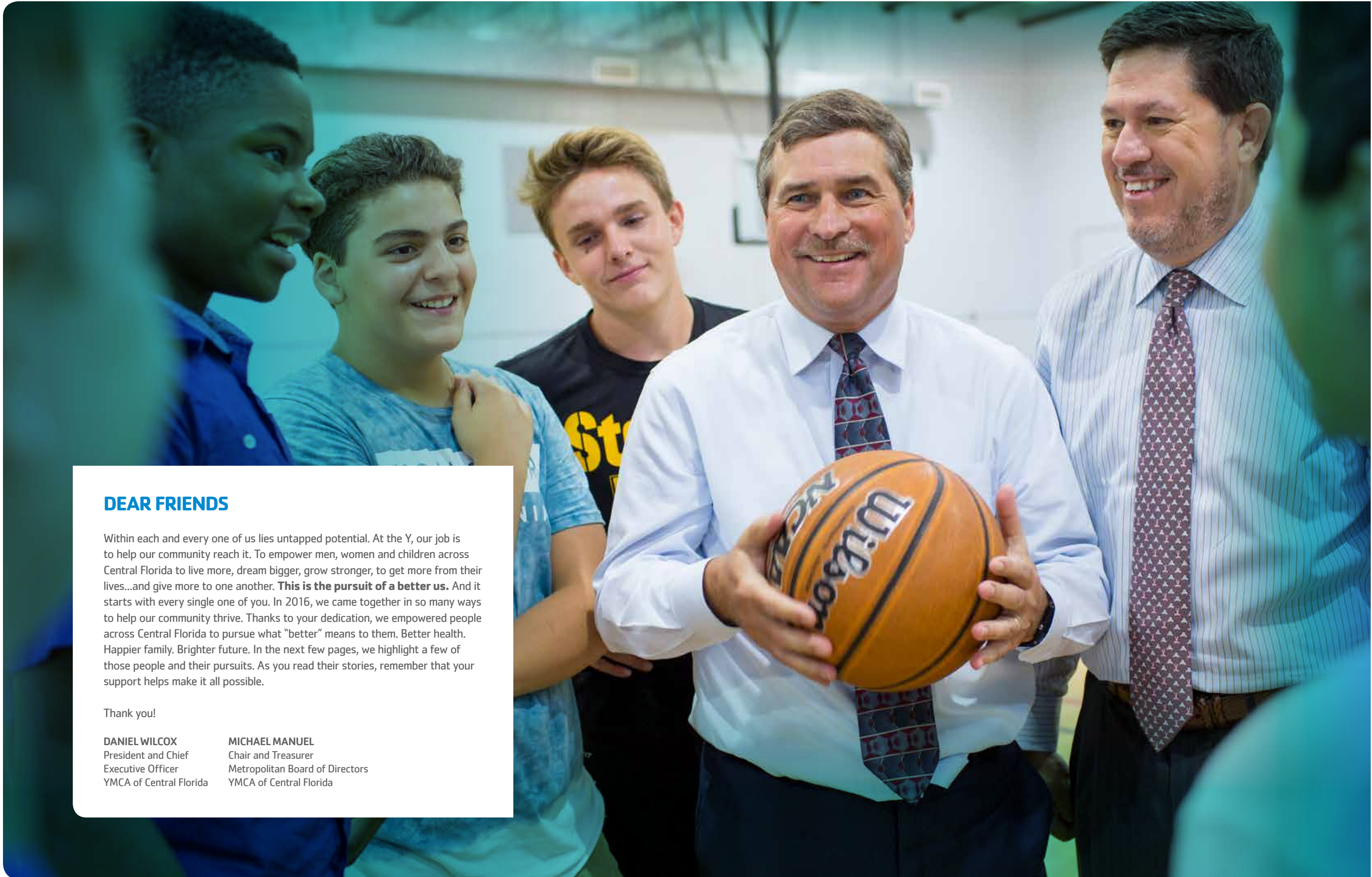

Collin Outerbridge had just moved into a new home when he spotted a young boy playing basketball alone across the street.

As someone with a heart for ministry and a desire to invest in his neighborhood, Collin felt it only natural to go shoot hoops with the young man, whose name is Jonah. A few ball games and mentoring sessions later, the boy's godfather, the pastor of **Vista Church in Orlando**, invited Collin to join their team.

Several years later, when Vista Church was looking to launch a **Lake Nona campus**, Collin saw another opportunity to offer ministry where people might not expect it. After a few conversations with community leaders, Collin held his first Sunday service at the **Lake Nona YMCA**.

Today, more than 400 people come to the Lake Nona Y for Sunday services with Pastor Collin. The church also offers bible study, which are taught by none other than Jonah. He's 21 now, and understands how important it is for kids to have strong spiritual role models. After all, he learned that lesson in his own driveway from a man who believes that "Church isn't about where you go. It's caring about wherever you are."

Being a strong open-water swimmer is a prerequisite for competing in a triathlon.

But that didn't stop **Marisabel Wolfinger** from taking the plunge when a friend mentioned the **Divas Tri Club** at the **Downtown YMCA**. She couldn't swim like a triathlete. Her bike wasn't great. Her running technique needed help. Still, she said "yes." Because if beating breast cancer at 37 taught Marisabel anything, it was that life's too short for regrets.

That attitude compelled Marisabel to quit the job that she'd held for 15 years since it no longer fulfilled her. It motivated her to train hard enough with the Divas Tri Club that she finished her first triathlon eight months after joining. It drove her across the finish line of her first Ironman, which she completed with her husband at her side. And when one of her connections came to her with an opportunity to start her own business, that "no regrets" philosophy inspired the only answer she could imagine. Yes. Yes to the business. Yes to fulfilling a lifelong goal. Yes to living life on her own terms.

"If I have an opportunity, I never assume it might come again. If you want to do something, do it. Otherwise, you'll never know about all the amazing things you're missing."

A LIFE BEYOND LIMITATIONS

Mealtime had always been tough for 8-year-old Christian.

The smell and texture of many foods sickened him, a common challenge for autistic children. Over the years, the limitations resulted in a diet filled with fast food items and unhealthy snacks. When a doctor said Christian was borderline diabetic, his mom, Veronica, knew it was time for a change.

Together, they enrolled in **Healthy Weight and Your Child**, a program at the **Dr. P. Phillips YMCA**. In the weeks that followed, they learned how to read nutrition labels and incorporate fruits and vegetables into

each meal. Christian realized that “exercise” was simply a fun time when you play with people you like. Now that he’s 10 pounds lighter, he even throws a flag on some meals and says, “We shouldn’t be eating this, Mom, let’s make another choice.”

As a mother, Veronica is grateful not only that Christian is healthier, but also that she and her son connect on a different level. It feels good when he chooses “mom time” over video games – and that he would rather play tennis than hang out inside.

But the biggest revelation for her is that Christian doesn’t have to be limited by his condition. “As long as we keep pushing down this road, I know the sky’s the limit for him.”

Kids need consistency.

As a mom, **Denise** understood how her family's routines gave her children a sense of security. So when she and her husband separated and moved toward divorce, the loss of structure is what scared her the most. With money getting tight, there wasn't any room in Denise's budget for the family's YMCA membership – even more disruption for kids who already had more than their fair share.

A scholarship from the **Dr. P. Phillips Y** was the answer to Denise's prayers. Despite everything else going on around them, her son and daughter never missed a beat with their basketball and soccer teams. Denise's daughter, who was recovering from back surgery, continued to rely on the Family Center gym for rehabilitation.

Denise received a different type of rehab in the form of the **Dave Ramsey Financial Peace classes** offered by the YMCA. She learned how to budget, save and live a comfortable life with her current income. And as Denise met other people going through the same thing, she found a new type of happiness.

"In these hard moments in your life, you need people who want to help you and embrace your situation. That doesn't happen very often," she said. "But I found it – and that's what made me so happy."

For most young boys, learning how to tie a necktie isn't high on their list of things to do over the summer.

Or ever. But **Tom Sommersdorf** has plenty of solid reasons why they should. So he showed up at the **South Orlando YMCA** with a pile of thrift-store rejects and taught about 20 boys how to tie a Windsor and a four-in-hand as part of the **Y's 3Fly mentoring program**. Now they'll be good to go for that high-stakes Q&A with a college scholarship committee, or even down the line when they land that dream job interview.

After retiring from the Orlando Police Department with more than 20 years on patrol in the city's roughest neighborhoods, Tom knows what teens in the **Oak Ridge area** are up against. He suspects things at home might not be great for a lot of them – but he doesn't ask. Instead, he shares stories about how he overcame his own challenges and leads conversations that range from diversity and inclusion to proper phone etiquette. And although some of the boys didn't know what to make of their mentor at first, they warmed up when they realized Tom was going to keep showing up for them, week after week.

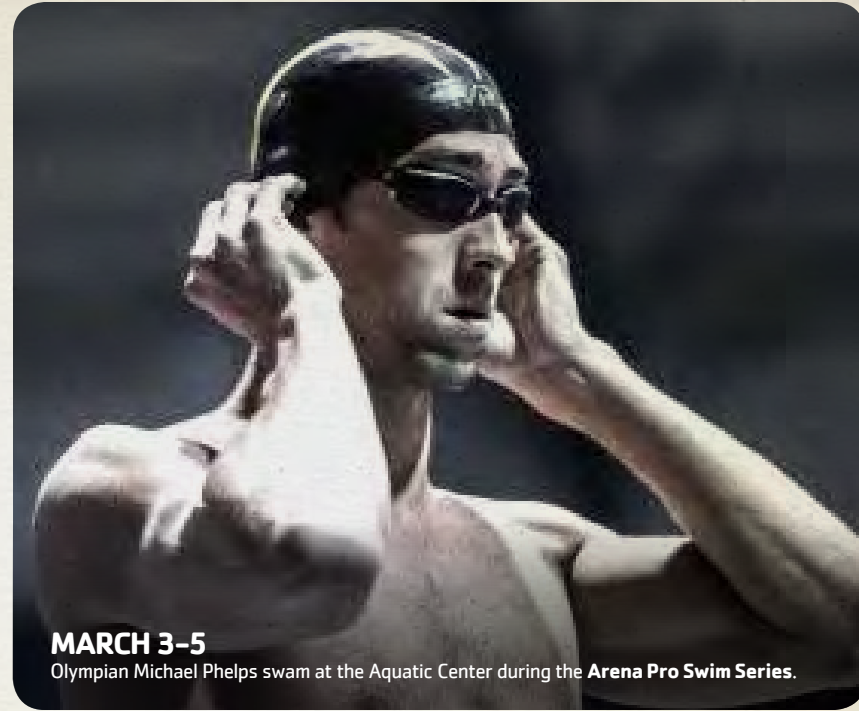

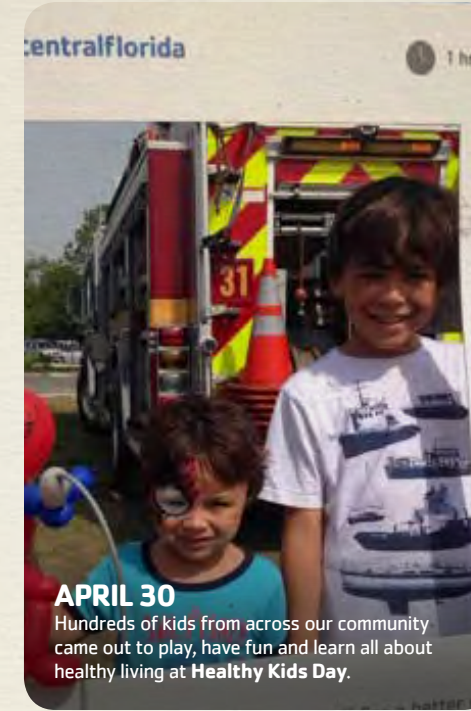
